

1. Login to your BPL eCard account by clicking on "My Account"




2. Select Boston Public Library Patrons, enter your card number and PIN



3. Search for book titles or subjects, or scroll down to browse collections.






5. Get ready to borrow your book. Click on the book cover to read a summary. Click borrow to check the book out, it can be borrowed for 7 or 14 days.
